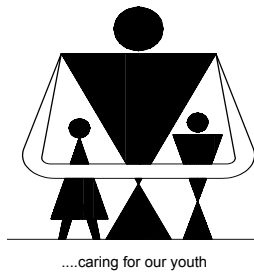

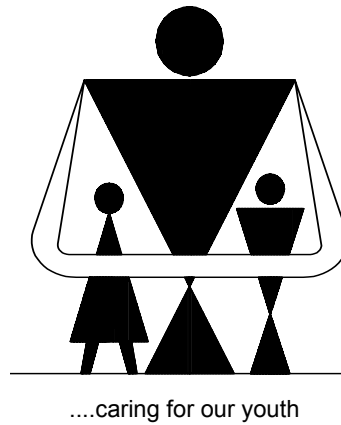

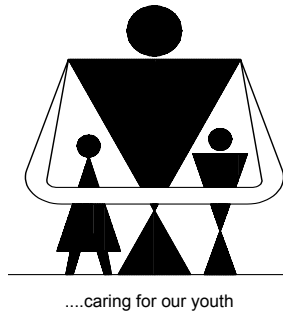

## CBM PROJECTS

### Peer Education and Reproductive Health Counseling for Young Men (PERCY)

The mission of the PERCY Project is to create an intervention model that helps pre-teen and teenage boys refrain from premature sex and make wise decisions in life through discussions on sexuality and other issues crucial to child development. *PERCY is funded by the Dept. of Health and Human Services, Office of Population Affairs.*

### Abstinence Program

The Abstinence Program encourages young people that the best way to avoid premature parenthood and sexually transmitted diseases is to remain abstinent until marriage. *This program is funded by the Office of Adolescent Pregnancy Program, Dept. of Health and Human Services.*

### Substance Abuse Prevention Program

This prevention project provides information on the dangers of substance abuse and how young people can succeed without using drugs. *SAP is funded by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).*

### Parent Self Improvement Project

The Parent Self Improvement Project helps the parents of our CBM children improve their educational, coping and parenting skills required to pursue job training, GED and work careers. *The program is funded by the DC government.*

### CYITC Tutoring Project

The CYITC Tutoring Program enhances the general academic performance of young people. This after-school project provides math and reading sessions with a specific focus on skills tested in the Stanford-9 Test. *The program is funded by the Children and Youth Investment Trust Corporation.*
